## **2006 EFR Instructor Course Pre-requisites & Schedule**

### **Pre-requisites:**

1. Have completed the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) course within the past 24 months
2. Have completed the Emergency First Response Secondary Care (First Aid) course within the past 24 months
3. Have completed the Emergency First Response Care for Children course within the past 24 months.
4. Those with current CPR/First Aid instructor credentials from other organizations may take the Emergency First Response Instructor Crossover Program.

### **Instructor Candidate Required Materials:**

Because teaching the Emergency First Response Primary Care course requires the ability to easily reference standards and maintain a library of updated materials, instructor candidates are required to have personal copies of the following materials for the instructor course and to teach Emergency First Response courses (unless they are unavailable in a language the instructor understands):
